2010 PERMISSIVE TAX EXEMPTION BYLAW NO. 839, 2009

A BYLAW TO EXEMPT CERTAIN LANDS AND IMPROVEMENTS
FROM MUNICIPAL TAXATION FOR THE YEAR 2010

WHEREAS Section 224 of the *Community Charter* authorizes the exemption of certain lands and improvements from municipal taxation, the Council of the District of Stewart, deems that the lands and improvements described within this Bylaw to be eligible for exemption from municipal taxation as they meet the qualifications of Section 224 of the *Community Charter*;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Stewart, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the following lands and improvements shown with the respective owners or occupiers shall be exempt from municipal taxation for the year 2010, pursuant to Section 224 of the *Community Charter*:
 - (1) Lands and improvements registered under the name of North American Baptist Conference – Association of BC Churches, as follows:

Lot 8-9, Block 18, D.L. 466, Plan 1191
PID: 012-979-457
012-979-465

(other than the land encompassing the building footprint and improvements identified as the church building at 617 – 6th Avenue)
2. The tax exemptions granted pursuant to this Bylaw cease to apply to property, when the use or ownership of which no longer conforms to the conditions necessary to qualify for exemption and, after this, the property is liable to taxation.
4. This Bylaw may be cited as the “**2010 Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaw No. 839, 2009**”.

READ A SECOND TIME this 13th day of October, 2009.

READ A THIRD TIME this 13th day of October, 2009.
