Assistance pursuant to sections 21 and 24 of the *Community Charter*

The District of Stewart ("District") gives notice of its intention to make available to the Stewart Community Connections Society ("SCCS") assistance under a partnering agreement between the District and SCCS dated for reference October 1, 2025. The assistance will be in the form of funding for a five-year period ending September 30, 2030. Annual funding amounts under the partnering agreement will be as follows:

- For the year ended September 30, 2026: \$57,500;
- For the year ended September 30, 2027: \$58,650;
- For the year ended September 30, 2028: \$59,823;
- For the year ended September 30, 2029: \$61,020; and
- For the year ended September 30, 2030: \$62,240.

The assistance will be for the purpose of assisting SCCS to carry out initiatives that are supportive of improving income and employment, housing, transportation, education, early childhood development, health, food security, financial empowerment, and recreation in the District of Stewart.

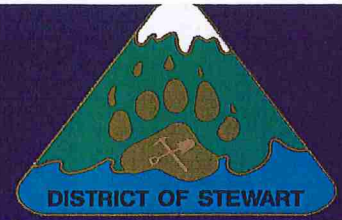
The District of Stewart ("District") gives notice of its intention to make available to the Stewart Historical Society ("SHS") assistance under a partnering agreement between the District and SHS dated for reference October 27, 2025. The assistance will be in the form of annual funding of \$30,000 per year for a three-year period ending December 31, 2028.

The assistance will be for the purpose of assisting SHS carry out initiatives that are supportive of collecting, preserving, exhibiting, and interpreting the history of the District of Stewart and the surrounding area and to operate and maintain a museum to house and display artifacts and archival records for the purpose of education, study, enjoyment, and enrichment of cultural life in the community.
