Barnachez bridge is being replaced beginning April 1, with completion anticipated for April 22. This means the Stewart Transfer Station will be closed until the project is complete.

Waste bins in the community will continue to be available to use.

If you have any big home renovation projects planned in April, consider waiting until the transfer station re-opens, so that you'll have somewhere to dispose of construction waste. Alternatively, the Meziadin Landfill is also an option.

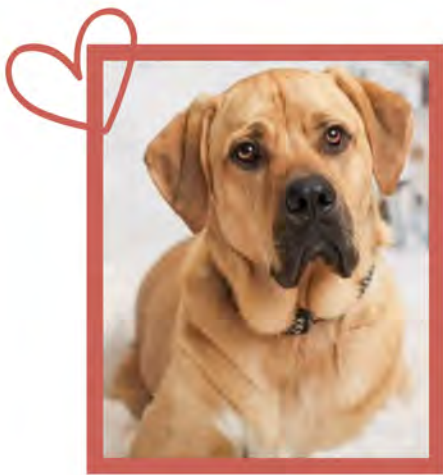
