Businesses located within the Municipal Boundaries of the District of Stewart seeking to renovate, restore or redesign retail storefronts and commercial building facades can receive a grant up to 50% of the cost of eligible improvements, to a maximum \$5,000 per project.

Licensed Home-based businesses can apply for funding for wayfinding signage at 50% to a maximum of \$500.
