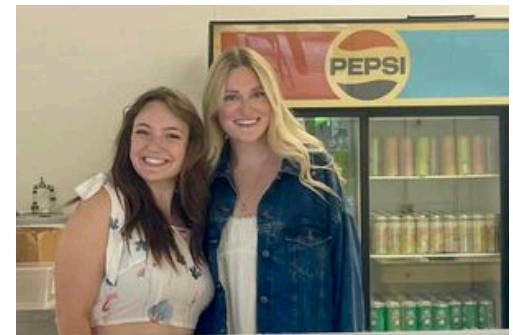

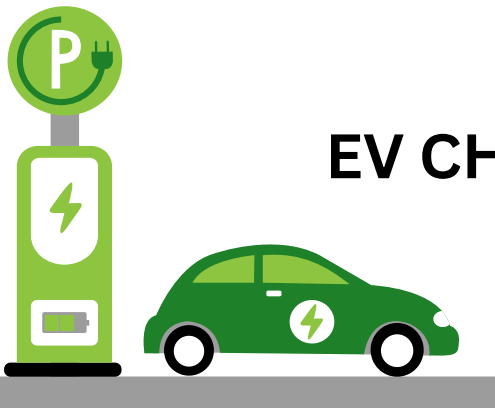
None of the many projects funded by the grant would have been possible if not for the hard work of dedicated volunteers.

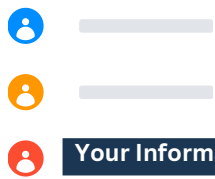
