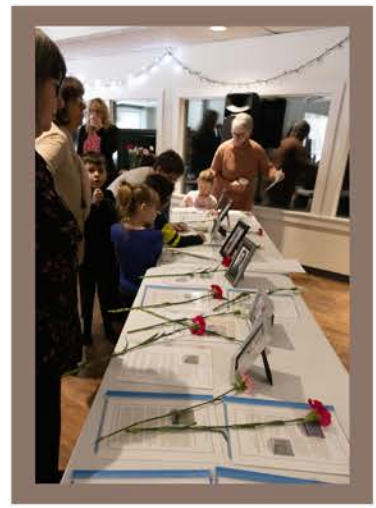


ICE CLOSED FOR THE SEASON AFTER MARCH 15TH 2025

The Ministry of Environment and Parks, Recreation Sites and Trails BC, invites interested contractors to submit quotes for the maintenance of Clements Lake recreation site near Stewart, BC. One contract will be individually awarded. This contract contains an "Option to Renew" clause for a period of up to 3 years, subject to funding and satisfactory performance of the contractor. Contractors will be required to provide their own transportation and tools. Some supplies and materials will be provided by the Ministry.
