Disposable Wipes Are Not Flushable!

For your benefit and the benefit of all sanitary sewer users in our community, be careful what you flush.

Newer styles of disposable wipes *claim* to be flushable as they are made of a fibrous material like toilet paper, but <u>all wipes clog the sewer</u> as they tend to twist together in the pipes and create obstructions.

Please DO NOT flush the following items as they can cause blockages:

- disposable hand towels
- baby wipes
- cosmetic and surface wipes
- feminine products

If you are not sure, please throw them in the trash. A clogged sewer line on your property may cost you a significant amount to repair and the District has no obligation to repair blockages beyond the property line.
